Note: If you bought a refurbished **Kindle Paperwhite 3G Walmart** unit, it might already be registered to the previous owner. A factory reset is advisable before you start: go to Settings > Device Options > Reset to Factory Defaults.

Caring for Your Kindle Paperwhite 3G

To ensure your investment from Walmart lasts for years, follow these simple maintenance tips:

- **Keep it clean:** Use a soft, slightly damp cloth to wipe the screen. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Protect the screen:** While the Paperwhite has a glass screen, it's still breakable. A case is strongly recommended.
- **Battery care:** The lithium-ion battery doesn't need full drains. Charge it when the battery gets low, but avoid letting it stay at 0% for extended periods.
- **Water resistance:** The Paperwhite 3G is IPX8 rated, meaning it can survive immersion in up to 2 meters of fresh water for 60 minutes. But it is not designed for salt water or soapy water. Rinse off any chlorine after pool use.
- **Software updates:** Keep the Kindle updated. Usually, updates happen automatically over Wi-Fi or 3G. You can check in Settings > Device Options > Advanced
