including Mr. Tickle, Mr. Greedy, Mr. Happy, Mr. Nosey, Mr. Sneeze, and Mr. Bump.

The success was immediate and overwhelming. The books were short, colourful, and perfectly pitched for early readers. The simple narratives, combined with bold illustrations, resonated with a wide audience. In 1981, the female counterpart series was introduced: **Little Miss**. Little Miss characters followed the same formula, with names like Little Miss Bossy, Little Miss Naughty, and Little Miss Sunshine. Together, the two series formed a universe of 85 original characters (43 Mr. Men and 42 Little Miss), later expanded by Adam Hargreaves after his father's death in 1988. Today, the entire collection includes over 90 characters,

and the series has sold over 100 million copies worldwide, translated into numerous languages.

- **Mr. Busy** – Blue, always rushing around doing things.
- **Mr. Brave** – Purple, fearless and always ready for adventure.
- **Mr. Grumpy** – Blue, always in a bad mood.
- **Mr. Forgetful** – Green, forgets everything constantly.
- **Mr. Jelly** – Pink, terrified of everything and easily frightened.
- **Mr. Noisy** – Yellow, incredibly loud in everything he does.
- **Mr. Lazy** – Orange, hates doing anything that requires effort.
- **Mr. Mean** – Purple, miserly and never shares anything.
- **Mr. Chatterbox** – Orange, talks non-stop without pause.
- **Mr. Fussy** – Pink, very particular about cleanliness and order.

- **Mr. Bounce** – Purple, cannot stop bouncing everywhere.
- **Mr. Muddle** – Brown, always confused and mixing things up.
- **Mr. Dizzy** – Blue and green, spins around until he falls over.
- **Mr. Impossible** – Blue, can do absolutely anything.
- **Mr. Strong** – Red, incredibly strong and muscular.
- **Mr. Worry** – Green, worries about everything possible.
- **Mr. Nonsense** – Purple, everything he says is complete nonsense.
- **Mr. Mischief** – Orange and blue, loves playing tricks on people.
- **Mr. Clumsy** – Yellow, always tripping and causing accidents.
- **Mr. No** – Blue, says no to everything.
- **Mr. Perfect** – Brown, does everything perfectly.
- **Mr. Cheerful** – Pink, always happy and cheerful.
- **Mr. Cool** – Blue, the coolest and most stylish character.
- **Mr. Rude** – Purple, very rude and impolite.
- **Mr. Good** – Yellow, always does the right thing.
- **Mr. Daring** – Green, brave and loves dangerous stunts.
- **Mr. Scatterbrain** – Orange, always distracted and forgetful.
- **Mr. Skinny** – Grey, extremely thin and tall.
- **Mr. Tall** – Green, unbelievably tall.
- **Mr. Small** – Already listed above, making 43 original Mr. Men.

Additional Little Miss Characters

Adam Hargreaves later added more characters to the **Little Miss** series, including Little Miss Bad, Little Miss Whoops, Little Miss Giggle, Little Miss Kind, and Little Miss Brave, expanding the family further. There are now well over 50 Little Miss characters in total.
